Fundraising in the workplace is a great way to motivate staff, it encourages and strengthens relationships between colleagues and is a chance to bring back some fun into the workplace, all whilst raising money for over 1,200 rescue animals that come into our centres each year. Here are a few of our favourite ideas to get you started:



Dress Down Day: a simple but effective way of making money, charge your staff members a fee for coming to work in their own clothes... maybe charge extra to let them wear their slippers.
