


Sisko

We could see that poor, sweet Sybil's eye was cloudy, crusty and inflamed. In this shockingly poor state, our vet couldn't even see her actual eye, and it was obviously very dry and sore. It's so sad to imagine the pain and discomfort this must have caused for Sybil.

After weeks of our team's determination, and using different medications to try to save her eye, we simply had to admit defeat and operate to remove it, to ensure she could live a pain-free and happy future.

Are you looking for the 'purrfect' place to relax in the beautiful Dorset countryside, enjoy a picnic and meet some gorgeous rescue animals?

If so, then we would love for you to visit our Church Knowle centre near Wareham! Nestled in the Isle of Purbeck and surrounded by rolling hills and wildlife, the centre offers spectacular views, a peaceful location to enjoy rural walks and, most importantly, the opportunity to see first-hand the work we do with animals in need.

Each week, our team hosts a variety of activities with our four-legged friends, including feeding our cheeky pigs their lunch, walking our horses and donkeys around the site and putting out baskets of branches for you to feed our lovely goats.

There's no better way to see the animals, and the difference you are making to those who find themselves homeless and in need of a helping hand. Don't forget that our centre is only a few miles away from Corfe Castle, Swanage Railway and Kimmeridge, so you could tie your visit into a full day of sightseeing!

The centre is open to visitors 6 days a week (closed on Wednesdays) from 11am - 3pm, and we'd love to invite you, your family and canine companions* to come along and enjoy an afternoon of animal-loving fun.
