

Job Description: Maintenance and Horticultural Assistant

Main Purpose of the role

To undertake routine maintenance and repair tasks respective to animal enclosures and associated areas. To assist with the maintenance and development of our gardens and grounds with an emphasis of adopting wildlife friendly gardening practices.

- To support the animal department team with ensuring enclosures are maintained to a high standard in support of animal welfare needs and presentation.
- To assist with the development and maintenance of the centres gardens and grounds in a manner empathetic with wildlife conservation.
- To work with the Centre Manager in developing a routine enclosure maintenance plan.
- To deliver high standards of customer service across all stakeholders.
- To support and promote the work of the charity.
- To represent the charity in a professional and caring manner.
